PUBLIC ADVISORY

Non-Presentation of Valid Philippine Passport / Identification Certificate (IC) / Recognition Certificate / Certificate of Re-acquisition or Retention of Philippine Citizenship (CRPC) in Departure from the Philippines

The Philippine Consulate in Guam informs the general public of the following recent guidelines issued by the Bureau of Immigration regarding travel to the Philippines:

- A. All passengers, who presented a (1) valid Philippine Passport; (2) Identification Certificate (IC); or (3) Certificate of Re-acquisition/Retention of Philippine Citizenship (CRPC) upon arrival and were admitted under the same status, shall be required to present the same during departure;
- B. All passengers who arrived using a Travel Document (TD) shall be required to secure and present any of the above mentioned documents during departure; and
- C. All departing passengers who fail to present any of the above mentioned documents shall not be allowed to depart.
