Documents required:

1. Death certificate
2. Certificate of embalment
3. Mortuary certificate that casket contains only the body of the deceased
4. Burial-Transit Permit
5. Philippine passport, if deceased is a citizen of the Philippines.

NOTE: Bodies of person who have died from cholera, small pox, leprosy, plague and anthrax or any communicable disease shall be properly embalmed and placed in a hermetically sealed metallic casket which shall later be enclosed in a wooden coffin or case which shall be strongly made and securely screwed or nailed, the parts of which shall have been carefully disinfected. Such bodies shall not be allowed to pass through Philippine quarantine until one year has elapsed since death occurred.
